Our School Uniform

Could we remind all our parents, carers and children about our Uniform expectations

Main Uniform

- Grey skirt or pinafore dress.
 - Grey trousers or shorts
 - Yellow polo-shirt or blouse
 - Royal blue sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan with or without school logo
 - White, grey or black sock or tights
 - Black shoes or black boots in winter (no trainers)
 - Light blue or yellow checked summer dress
- FOOTWEAR - For health and safety reasons, pupils must wear flat, closed toe shoes that are black in colour.

We have increasing numbers of children attending school in trainers and boots of different colours.

Jewellery: We ask children not to wear jewellery for safety reasons. It can be caught whilst your child is playing or working and hurt your child or be broken. It can also be easily lost. If your child has pierced ears then we would appreciate you ensuring they wear stud earrings.

P.E Kit: It is essential your child has their P.E kit in school so that they can take part in their P.E lessons which are essential part of the curriculum.
