



## Programme of Extra-Curricular Learning Opportunities & Children's University

Extra-curricular learning opportunities each term, validated by the Children's University, enrich the lives of our children at Manor Primary with a wide range of exciting, creative and innovative out-of-school learning opportunities.

We will begin a new programme of extra-curricular clubs the week beginning **Monday 17th September 2018** and will take place after school some evenings. There is something for every year group in school and our Pupil leadership team worked collaboratively with teachers to select a range of clubs based on their feedback so there is something to suit all of our children.

We continue to be part of the Wolverhampton Children's University, a scheme offering children aged 5-14+ exciting and innovative programme of high quality learning opportunities outside school hours, with a focus on rewarding participation, raising aspirations and encouraging engagement with learning. All of our extra-curricular clubs outlined below have been validated by Wolverhampton Children's University. Children will be provided with passports and each time they attend an extra-curricular club the time they have spent is logged onto their passport. **This year, once again children will graduate if they achieve 100 hours or more and they will receive a gold award or awards that follow the gold award.** All of their hours from previous years will be carried forward. More details of this will follow as we approach graduation for this academic year.

If you wish your child to take part in any club please fill in a slip below giving consent. **If your child wants to take part in more than one club please fill a slip in for each club.** Slips should be returned to your child's class teacher by **Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> September** Children cannot swap clubs during the term as they are all new programmes leading to their university certificates they have to complete full programmes.

For all clubs numbers are not restricted if you indicate on a slip you want your child to take part they will have a place.

On the day of their club, at the end of the school day, children will go to their clubs and can be collected after they have finished from the school gate/ Infant or KS2 yard. Staff will bring children out as they normally do at the end of the day. **Clubs for Reception will begin in the Spring Term once they have settled into full time school.**

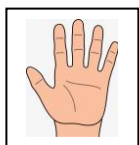
