Our learning this term in Year 3:



English

<u>Maths</u>

In English we will be learning to read and write a range of texts, both fiction and non-fiction. This will include stories with a familiar setting, a range of information texts and poetry. Children will write using basic grammar and punctuation accurately. Children will develop their understanding of narrative, non-fiction texts and poetry and have opportunities to create them.

In Mathematics we will be learning to extend our understanding of number and the four number operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be collecting, recording and interpreting data and developing our understanding of 2D and 3D shapes. We will begin to understand the place value of digits in numbers up to 1000.

Scie

<u>Science</u>

In Science we be learning that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food. We will be learning that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Geography



In Geography we will be learning about The British Isles. We will develop an understanding of how the British Isles is made up. The children will be encouraged to develop their knowledge about places and their locations.

<u>History</u>

In History we will be learning about what it was like for children during World War II. We will find out about a major event in world history and develop their understanding of reasons for and results of an event of such significance.



RE

In RE will be thinking about How the World Began. We will reflect on ideas of creation and investigate the ways in which the Christian, Muslim and Hindu faiths explain creation.



PHSCE

In PHSCE we will investigate what makes a healthy lifestyle, including the benefits of exercise and healthy eating. We will explore how advertising affects people's choices about food.



PE

In PE we will learn the skills applied to playing invasion games and learning multi skills



DT

In DT we will be designing and making biscuits. The children learn how to adapt a basic recipe and investigate existing products from all cultures that will inform their design ideas.




Computing

In computing we will develop understanding of animation, using digital tools to create their own animation.



<u>Art</u>

In Art and Design we will investigate how paintings, prints, photographs and other images communicate ideas about relationships. They focus on sketching in proportion and drawing accurately hands and feet.



Modern Foreign Languages

In French we will learn to introduce themselves, greet others and say how they are. They begin to respond to and ask questions about name and age. They begin to recognise some letter names in French.



Music

We will listen to and appraise a reggae song called Three Little Birds by Bob Marley. They will explore Pulse/Rhythm/Pitch
