Children in Year 2 will begin their art journey exploring colours!

In this unit children will investigate primary colours and will get Colour Creative exploring ways to make secondary colours. In addition, children will explore tones, shades of colour, lighter and darker and begin to investigate how different colours can make you feel, reflecting different emotions.

We will learn about artist Joan Miro and how he used colour to create different effects and we will

investigate his style!

Sculpture and 3D Art in our community and Beyond

In this unit children will build on prior knowledge from year I and continue to develop new knowledge and techniques when creating Super Sculptures and 3D artwork.

Children will develop their understanding of shape, form, texture and explore the sensory qualities of a range of materials. They will learn about how to create different effects to make artwork 3Dimentional.

The children will take a step back in time, delving into links with their Hot Hot Hot History learning about...

The Great Fire of London, investigating what buildings were like, taking inspiration and key features to design, plan and make a 3D sculpted building from the year 1666!

Digital Media: Our Diverse World

In this unit children will explore a topical issue and will learn how to use ICT to create art. Children will use a viewfinder to focus their attention to detail within a piece of art understanding how this links to photography and framing specific detail. Children will create frames of images to storyboard and communicate a message using cameras, photography, text and speech bubbles, editing their digital artwork. They will tell a story through their art in a comic strip style.
