

## Literacy

I will explore rhyming stories and texts related to Day and Night.  
I will predict the outcome of a story using picture clues and repeated text.  
I will recognise rhythm in spoken words by clapping and tapping syllables in words.  
I will use pictures to tell a story or convey a message.

## Maths

I will use counting rhymes to count forwards and backwards.  
I will count sounds and physical movements.  
I will identify a number as a symbol.  
I will sort numbers from letters  
I will identify shapes in the environment.  
I will begin to name simple 2D shapes  
I will construct and deconstruct shapes, looking at the features of each shape.

## PD

I will develop my fine motor skills through threading, malleable resources, tweezers and writing tools.  
I will continue to develop my eye-hand co-ordination  
I will dress and undress with support.  
I will use a range of movements using apparatus and equipment.  
I will use scissors correctly to follow a line.  
I will use anticlockwise movements using my gross motor skills.

## Communication & Language

I will use action words to develop awareness of sounds and rhythms.  
I will distinguish between sounds and to remember patterns of sounds.  
I will acquire language through repetition.  
I will listen to others one to one or in small groups.  
I will listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.  
I will begin to understand 'why' and 'how' questions.
