In this unit children will develop an understanding of the countries that are in the United Kingdom. They will develop their skills of map reading and using an atlas. Children will explore the meaning of the word 'island' and how that is used in relation to the UK. By the end of this unit, children will be able to identify distinguishing features of the individual countries in the UK and the seas that surround each country. Children will begin to develop their geographical knowledge and language to discuss a small area of the UK.



My community, My country

In this unit children will explore this wonderful country and their local community. Children will be able to build upon their mathematics learning in terms on directional language and using their wonderful knowledge of bar charts and pictograms. First hand experiences are an exciting part of geography and the children will be able to take part in first hand experiences of exploring their local area and investigate wider areas through photographs – exploring both human and physical geography. Children will be able to use a map of the UK to understand where they live in relation to other parts of the UK. Finally, children will be able to suggest how to make positive changes to their local area!



Geography Curriculum Overview Year One

Sensational Seaside Locations

In this sensational coastal unit, the children will learn about the seaside locations in the UK and compare them with the contrasting locations in Europe. Children will be able to draw upon any previous prior knowledge and look at photographs of seaside locations and identify any similarities and differences between the two. In this unit, children will focus on the human and physical features of a seaside location in each of the four counties within the United Kingdom. Children will be able to identify the seven continents in the world and the five oceans in an atlas. By the end of this unit, children will be able to articulate their opinions on what costal location they would like to live at and why.
