Contact tracing over the Easter holidays

Schools have been asked once again to support the NHS Test and Trace process over the Easter holidays.

If a child tests positive and if either symptoms or a positive test occurred within 2 days of them being in school, could parents and carers please inform school at info@manorprimary.com so that we can assist in identifying close contacts and advise self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.

Where symptoms or a positive test occurred more than 2 days since the child was last in school this does not need to be reported to us and contact tracing is not required. Where this is the case, staff, students, parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace
