Ensure that there is enough space for pedestrians to walk past when parking on the curb.

After half term we are going to begin to formalise our approach to Beyond the Bell Learning and will be able to share our expectations with you next week.

The school day

From next week, **Monday 24th May** we are going to amend the times of the school day for Reception to give the children slightly more time for afternoon learning.

The end of the reception day will be **2.55pm**, (currently 2.45pm), this will enable the children to access more learning time across the week.

In order to support the end of the day, reception parents **only** will be allowed on the playground at 2.50pm to wait for the children to leave school. We would ask parents and carers to support us ensuring that we stay safe and social distance.

After half term we are going to adjust the start of the school day, with a slightly later start. The gates will be opened at **8.40am** to allow the children into school, registers will be done in class at **8.55am** (anyone arriving in class after this time will receive a late mark) and gates will be closed at **9.00am**

Rather than allocate a start time for each year group at the start of the day we are hoping that parents will make an informed choice about the time that they bring their child to school taking into account how busy things are at the start and end of the day.
