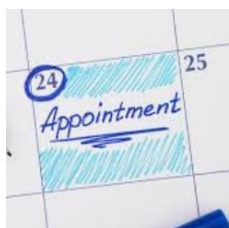

Water Bottles

We have purchased new water bottles for all our children which are going home this week. The water bottles should be sent to school empty each day so they can be filled with water in school, these will be sent home at the end of the school day so that they can be washed.

The children will have their name written on the bottle. Please could we ask children not to put stickers or write over their bottles so that individual names can be clearly seen by staff and children.

Bags in School

If children want to bring a small bag to school to put their fruit, lunchbox and water bottle in, they can. Please ensure that the bag or backpack is not too large and these have to be stored in the classrooms and if not stored correctly can present as a tripping hazard.



We have had a number of parents contact school regarding parking at the start and end of the school day. Parents are asked ensure that there is sufficient space for pedestrians when parking on the pavement.

Please ensure that you drop children off at the start of the day safely. Some parents are stopping their cars in the middle of the road for children to get out which could potentially lead to an accident.
