Free School Meal Food Parcels

Many thanks to our parents and carers for responding to our ParentMail regarding our Food parcels. Today we are confirming the numbers that are needed and we will be able to share details about when parents can pick up their boxes.

Guidance from the DFE states – *We are going to provide extra funding to support schools to provide food parcels or meals to eligible children. Where schools cannot offer food parcels or use local solutions, we will ensure a national voucher scheme is in place so that every eligible child can access free school meals while their school remains closed.*

Our school catering company is able to provide food parcel and this is now why we are providing food parcels rather than vouchers.
